



## Youth Programmer: Summer Student

The Youth Programmer: Summer Student will work alongside staff from Frog Hollow youth programs to provide support to youth of different ages. This includes working with youth one-on-one, providing resources and referrals, and group facilitation.

<b>Position:</b>	Youth Programmer: Summer Student
<b>Hours:</b>	35 hours/week, may include evening and weekend work
<b>Salary:</b>	\$21/hour
<b>Term:</b>	8 week period before August 31, 2021

### Duties and Responsibilities:

- Support youth participants in various programs
- Mediate, support, and act as a role model for participants
- Empower youth by actively encouraging their involvement in program planning
- Ensure the safe keeping and proper use of FHNH facilities and equipment
- Ensure the safety and well-being of participants in the program
- Provide support within youth services by responding to youth inquiries; providing information about various community resources; answering the phone; scheduling client appointments
- Update youth-specific community resources

### Qualifications:

Applicants must be eligible for funding under the Canada Summer Jobs program. Eligible students:

- are between 15 and 30 years of age;
- are Canadian citizens or permanent residents or have official refugee protection status under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act (foreign students are not eligible); and
- are legally entitled to work in Canada, according to relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations

### In addition, the successful candidate will possess the following skills:

- Completed or pursuing post-secondary education in social work, social sciences, or a similar field
- Experience working with and supporting marginalized youth
- Knowledge of employment supports and job search activities
- Experience mentoring youth and working with community members of all ages
- Ability to communicate inter-culturally in a fast-paced multi-cultural setting
- Proficiency in a second language is an asset
- Current First Aid and CPR certification or willingness to obtain
- Food Safe certificate or willingness to obtain
