Frog Hollow Neighbourhood House is looking for a passionate, creative and committed individual to join our dynamic, Reggio-inspired team as an Assistant Team Lead or Team Lead for our Infant/Toddler program, at our Village location on the rooftop of Lord Nelson Elementary School. This is a temporary Maternity Leave position up to one year. Our team is passionate, collaborative, inspired by the Reggio Emilia Approach and we apply its principles and values in concert with the values of Frog Hollow Neighbourhood House. We are part of Frog Hollow's integrated "Reggio-Inspired Learning Centre" (<http://www.reggiolearning.ca/>) with amazing opportunities for professional development and collaborative initiatives with other educators and with the community as a whole. As a member of the Association of Neighbourhood Houses of BC (ANHBC), Frog Hollow Neighbourhood House is recognized for our innovative, inclusive and welcoming approach in working with families, staff, volunteers and our community.

Responsibilities:

The Infant Program Assistant Team Lead or Team Lead is responsible for the provision of quality care and education for the children in our Infant program. We are an inclusive, multicultural, dynamic and collaborative child care setting which includes working with other educators to plan and implement a progressive and innovative program inspired by the Reggio Emilia approach.

Other responsibilities include developing strong relationships and communication with children, families and colleagues, and implementing high standards of care and supervision that promote the well being of all children. Along with supporting the children in their day to day activities this position is supporting the staff team of the Infant program and working closely with all other Village Program Leads (Infant/Toddler, 3-5 programs, School Age Program) and the Early Years and School Age Coordinators in creating a Village community environment. They will also have the opportunity to work with team leads of all other Frog Hollow Childcare programs.

- Willingness to provide emergent programming based on the principles of the Reggio Emilia approach
- Knowledge of the Early Learning Framework (BC)

- Passion for constant learning in partnership with children, families and colleagues
- An eagerness to work as part of a collaborative, supportive and dynamic team in a non-profit and volunteer-based organization. This includes working with all other Village Team Leads, Village Coordinators, and all other Frog Hollow Childcare Team leads.
- Leadership and mentorship in the implementation and commitment to Frog Hollow Neighbourhood House's values, and our Reggio-Inspired Learning Centre values and principles
