



School Age Support Worker

Frog Hollow Neighbourhood House's School Age Programs are looking for a caring, mature, energetic, flexible individual to work as a Support Worker with children requiring extra support in our School Age Programs and overall with all the children in the school age programs. Our childcare team is passionate and inspired by the Reggio Emilia Approach and we apply its principles and values in concert with the values of FHNH. We are a Learning Centre with amazing opportunities for professional development and for collaborative efforts with other educators and with the community as a whole. As a member of the Association of Neighbourhood Houses of BC (ANHBC), FHNH is recognized for our innovative and inclusive approach in working with staff, volunteers and community.

Responsibilities:

The School Age Care Support Worker will be responsible for overseeing and leading the full integration of children who require one to one and/or extra support into the school age programs. The position may require working with or in multiple School Age Care locations operating within the Frog Hollow Neighbourhood House. This also includes working together with the staff team and with the child/ren to attain goals determined by Supported Childcare, and to provide personal care when required.

Other responsibilities include developing strong relationships and communication with children, families and colleagues, and implementing high standards of care and supervision that promote the well being of all children.

Qualifications Required:

- Completion of a 20 hour course, or a combination of courses in child development, guidance, health and safety, or nutrition (or willingness to obtain)
- Knowledge of the Early Learning Framework
- Special Needs Training and Education an asset
- First Aid Certificate
- Strength in building and maintaining supportive and collaborative partnerships with families
- Passion for constant learning in partnership with children, families and colleagues in a non-profit and volunteer-based organization
- Experience working with children requiring additional support in inclusive settings.
- Ability to work cooperatively in a non-profit and volunteer-based organization
- Creativity, initiative, enthusiasm, positive attitude and a sense of humor

Hours: 18.5hrs/wk 2:30 to 6:00pm with a one hour/week meeting and an opportunity to work up to full days on Professional Days and School Breaks. This is a great opportunity for persons attending a post-secondary institution and we can be flexible around days of the week you are available.

Rate and benefits: \$21.31-22.43/hr plus Group Medical Benefits (EH, Dental), Company Pension Plan, and vacation and sick time. **If you are ECE qualified, this position is eligible for the \$4.00 WE.** We also offer the option of temporary contracts if this is more suitable to your schedule.
