### **Responsibilities:**

The Infant/Toddler Educators will be responsible for the provision of quality care and education for the children in our Infant-Toddler Programs at either our Village @ Lord Nelson or Satellite Daycare Sites. The individuals will work with the other team members throughout the daily operations to ensure children are provided with proper care and activities that reflect our philosophies. The individuals will also participate in the documentation, the programming and the classroom environment creation to support children's holistic development and well-being based on the BC Early Learning Framework, Frog Hollow values, and Reggio Emilia approach.

Other responsibilities include developing strong communication and relationships with children, families and colleagues. The Infant and Toddler Educators work closely with other educators, Team Leads, and the Early Years and School Age Coordinators in creating a positive community environment for children, families and staff.
